The family continued to travel until Adam returned to Atlanta to attend the Atlanta College of Art. He completed his Bachelor of Fine Arts and has been painting full-time since then. He is now twenty-two years old and has been painting most of his life. His work has a maturity beyond his years and is already collected nationally and internationally.
