Rob Scotton was born September 26, 1960 in England. He is a bestselling author and artist who received his education at Leicester Polytechnic where he graduated with honors. Rob Scotton and his wife Liz, who is also an artist, currently reside in Rutland, England where Rob Scotton imagined, created, writes and illustrates the popular children s book characters, Russell the Sheep and Splat the Cat.

The idea that created the Russell the Sheep series came to Rob Scotton as he was riding his bike through a field in Rutland, England. Believing that a story about sheep that do nothing but eat and stare would be boring to young readers, Scotton came up with a silly, fun-loving character named Russell the sheep who lives in Frogsbottom Field. Offset Lithograph

The offset lithography process works by first transferring an image photographically to thin metal, paper, or plastic printing plates. Unlike other forms of printing, the image on the printing plate is not recessed or raised. Rollers apply oil-based ink and water to the plates. Since oil and water don't mix, the oil-based ink won't adhere to the non-image areas. Only the inked image portion is then transferred to a rubber blanket (cylinder) that then transfers the image onto the paper as it passes between it and another cylinder beneath the paper.

The term offset refers to the fact that the image isn't printed directly to the paper from the plates, but is offset or transferred to another surface that then makes contact with the paper.
